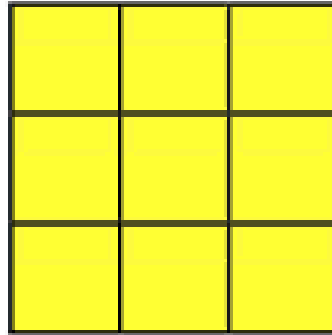
- Title page (topic of the project)
